

## SMART Tags / START Triage

Purpose: The program is designed to educate EMTs on using START triage during mass casualty events and using SMART Triage Tags to document patient's priority, treatment and transport.

Objectives: After completion of the program the EMT should be able to

- Define MCI & triage
- Assign a priority to patients involved in an MCI
- Use the SMART Triage Tag to indicate patient priority, document patient care, identify contamination status and track patient transportation.
